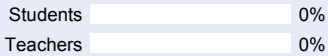

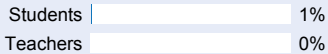

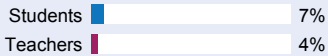

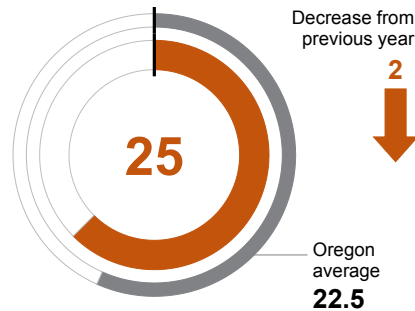

School Environment

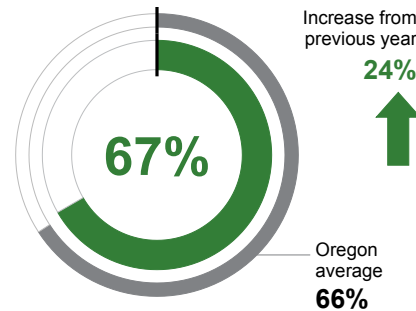
CLASS SIZE

REGULAR ATTENDERS

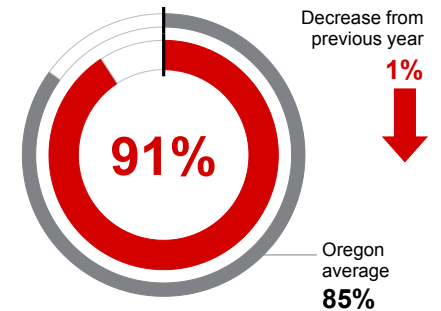
Students who attended more than 90% of their enrolled school days.

ON-TRACK TO GRADUATE

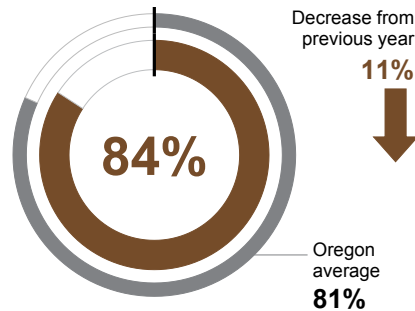
Students earning one-quarter of graduation credits in their 9th grade year.

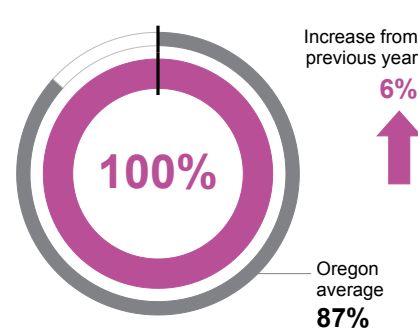
ON-TIME GRADUATION

Students earning a diploma within four years. Cohort includes students who were first-time ninth graders in 2019-20 graduating in 2022-23.



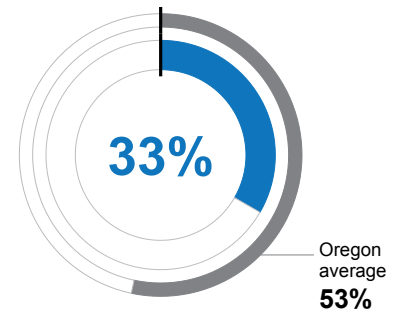
FIVE-YEAR COMPLETION

Bridge Charter Academy partners with parents to cultivate student's curiosity and love for wisdom. About Our School

ADVANCED COURSEWORK

Bridge Charter Academy offers advanced coursework individualized to students' goals and abilities. All our students can access AP courses through an online curriculum or complete Student-Directed Learning Experiences with Honors. For students who desire to pursue a 4-year degree or 2-year certification program, we have multiple tracks available, including our Dual Credit Scholarship program with local colleges and our expanding CTE Scholarship programs for both high school and college-level hands-on training.

CAREER & TECHNICAL EDUCATION

Bridge Charter Academy offers High School and College level Career & Technical Education in various career pathways. Career pathways are multiple courses within a career area that use a combination of curriculums and include an internship in the field.

EXTRACURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

Bridge Charter Academy offers on-campus extracurricular programs to our students at both our Bend and Lowell campuses. The program currently includes a music program, pottery and clay creation classes, archery, a woodshop, and more. Off-campus offerings are also available.

PARENT & COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT

In addition to attending community-building-in-person classes, students at Bridge Charter Academy meet regularly with their teachers and educational coaches to review their progress, reflect on their learning, and plan for their continued growth. High School students have opportunities to participate in student government and community internships. Families engage regularly with the Bridge Charter Academy program through weekly emails, weekly family meetings, and by joining other parents in the Parent Center, an informal meeting space for families using the program to connect.
